Additional Notes:

- Residency Requirements:
 - 31 hours overall must be from ASU
 - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
 - 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
 - Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)

- UCO 1200:
 - Waived for transfer students w/ more than 30 transferrable hours.
 - Students should take 3 s.h of Free Electives, in lieu of UCO 1200, to meet degree requirements.
 - Requirement satisfied by completion of AA/AS.
