**Additional Notes:**

- The Individually Designed concentration requires approval from the department chairperson.
- A contract for the Individually Designed concentration must be on file with the dean’s office before a senior check or graduation check-out can be done.
- Residency Requirements:
  - 31 hours must be from ASU
  - 18 hours in the major must be from ASU
  - 9 hours in the minor must be from ASU
  - Final 30 hours must be courses taken through ASU (includes internships, study abroad taken through ASU)
